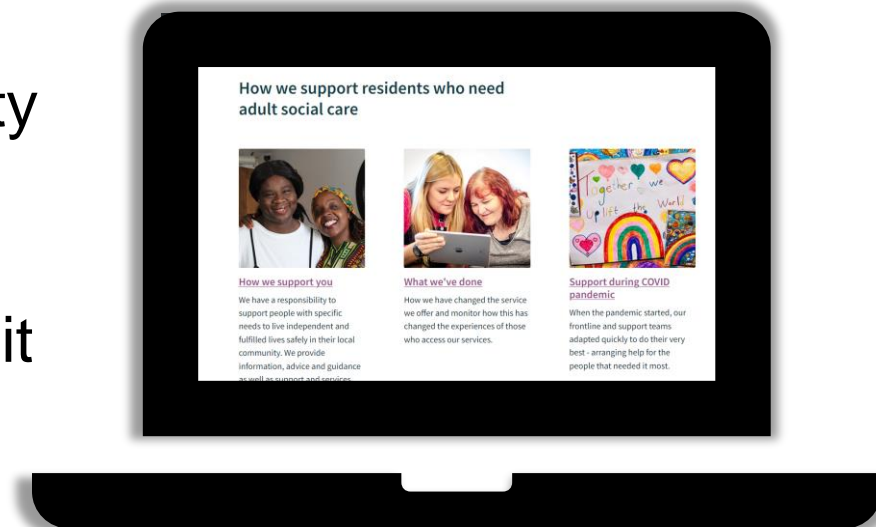
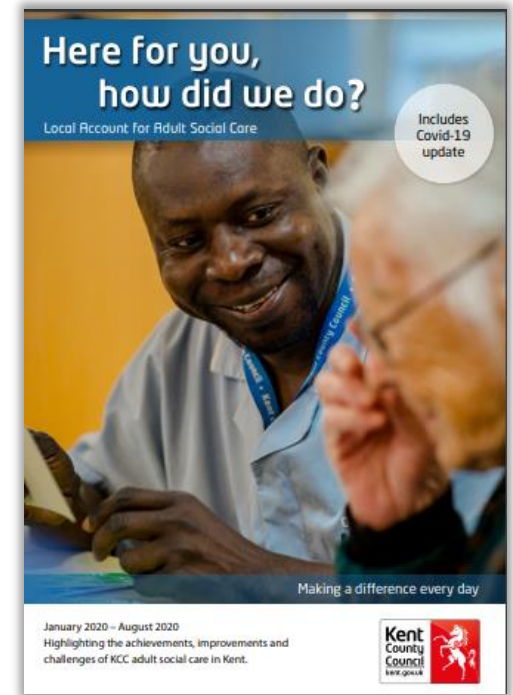


Looking back
