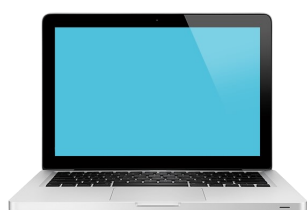

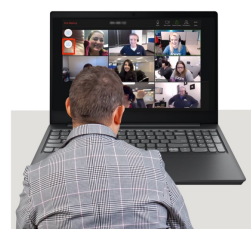
## Future Meeting Dates
