What has been done?

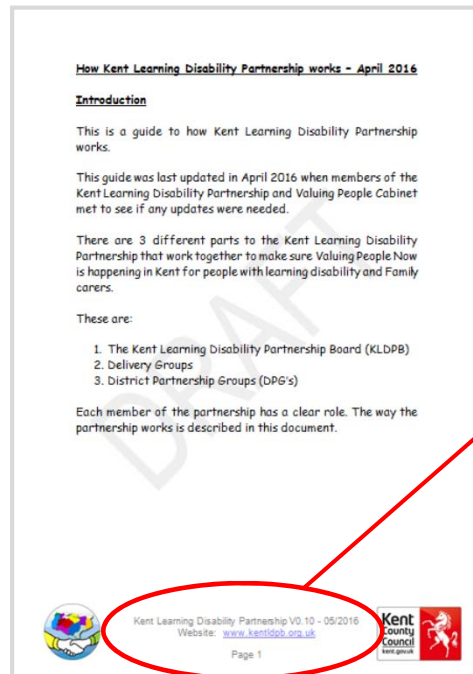

The website address for the Kent Learning Disability Partnership has been added to the bottom of each page.



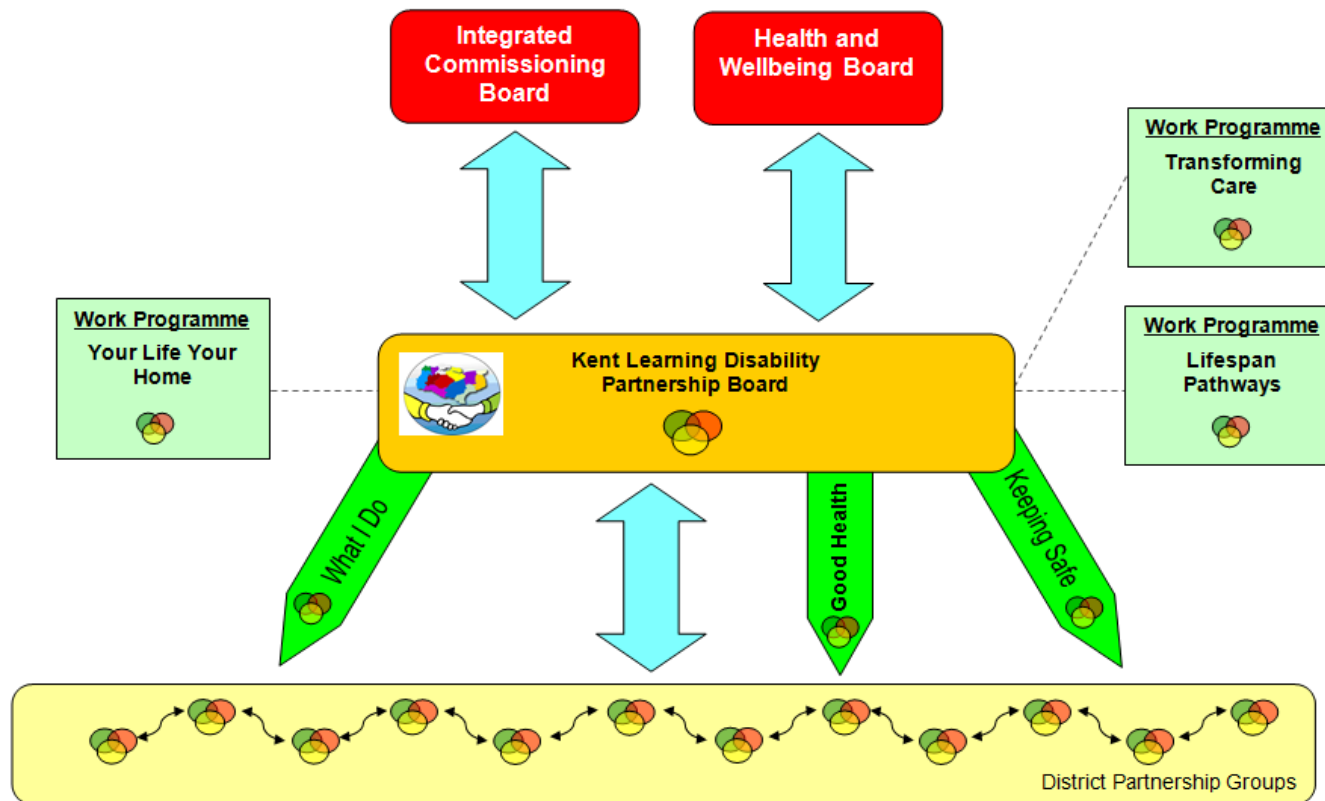

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What changes have been made?

The Kent Partnership structure now shows a link to the Integrated Commissioning Board.



What changes have been made? (Page 3)

The wording on the Joint Commissioning plan has been changed and now reads:

PLEASE NOTE: The Partnership Strategy ended in 2015. Therefore, the Kent LD Partnership will be working to the new Joint Commissioning Plan. This plan is being worked on and a draft will be brought to the Kent Learning Disability Partnership Board.

What changes have been made? (Page 6)

Members of the Kent LD Partnership Board:

- There will be an Integrated Commissioner to represent all LD commissioning.
- There will be up to five family carer reps from the District Partnership Groups. These will be the five reps from the existing VPN Cabinet and Kent LD Partnership Board



What changes have been made? (Page 6)

Members of the Kent LD Partnership Board events:

- We will invite the five family carer reps from the District Partnership Groups.
- We will invite representatives from the carers' organisations. These are: Carers First, Involve Carers, East Kent Carers Consortium.

Work of the Good Health Delivery Group. We have added the following work:

- Health Promotion
- Community Services (e.g. community LD teams, chiropody, sexual health)
- Mental Health and Living Well
- Health Screening (e.g. breast, cervical and bowel)



Questions

Q. The membership list for the Kent Learning Disability Partnership Board does not seem to include anyone from health?

A. The list includes the Joint Chairs of each of the Delivery Groups. This includes the Good Health Group which is jointly chaired by the Consultant in Public Health.



Number of events per year

Concern was shown about asking District Partnership Groups (DPGs) to attend two events a year due to the level of work to support and prepare people.

It was also suggested that there is a celebration at the end of the KVPP contract to look at the work done by the DPGs over the past 6 years and to hear about plans going forward.



Our suggestion to you

Therefore, we suggest that we hold a minimum of 1 event a year.

If a second event is wanted, this would be held instead of one of the Board meetings.

There would be a maximum of 2 events a year.
