We propose there should be a question about the activities people are supported to do.

This is not a Transforming Care contract, but we know from Transforming Care work that people need this to be safe and well.

PROPOSED QUESTION:

“How will individuals be supported to do activities that are meaningful for them, including accessing their local community?”





We also have a Social Value question.

Social Value is about adding other things that make life better in Kent, apart from providing care and support.

Jobs for disadvantaged people is one kind of Social Value.



PROPOSED QUESTION:

“What commitments will you make through this contract to create jobs for people who are disadvantaged, as Social Value and positive action under the Equality Act 2010?”



Examples can include:

- apprenticeships for young people looked after by KCC**
- supported internships for young people with learning disabilities and/or autism**
