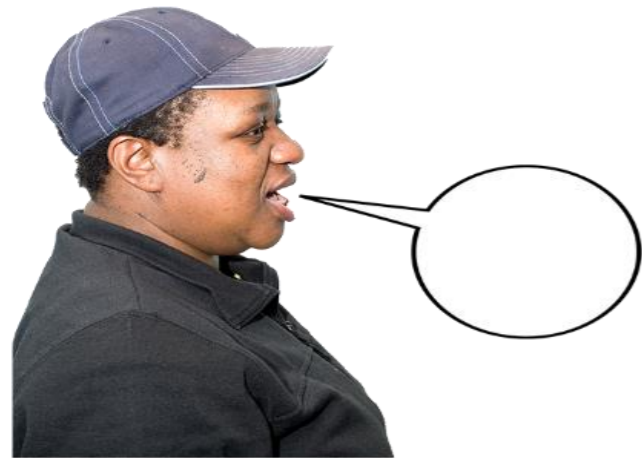


Learning Disability Partnership Board reset – next steps

Background – what has been done so far?



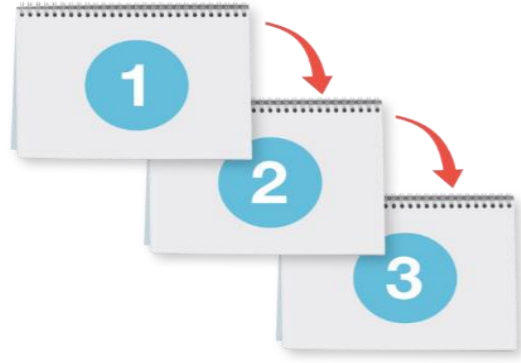
Sam Clark from Learning Disability England joined the last meeting to talk about how the Partnership Board could work in the future.



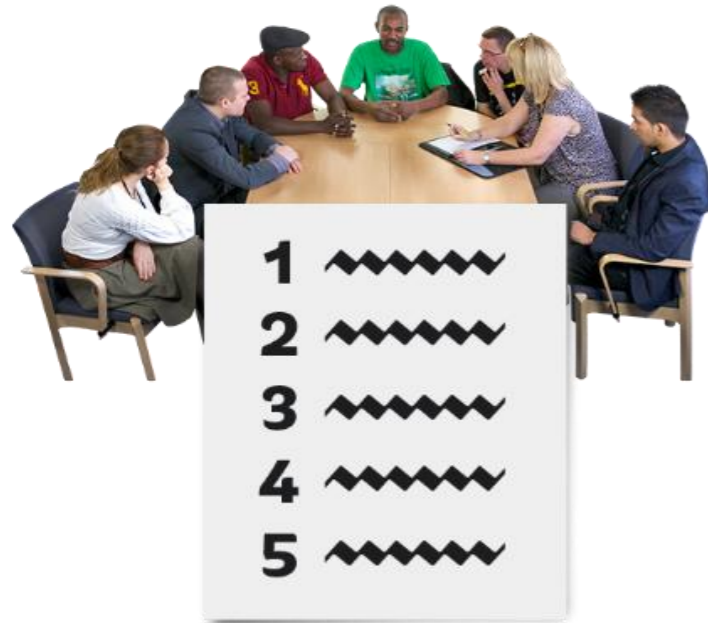
Board members talked about this at the meeting.

There were lots of ideas.

What people said could be looked at during the review



All the ideas have been grouped into three big areas to be worked on during the review.



1. How the board and meetings work
2. How the board is connected to other people or groups
3. How the board can make a difference

What can we do next?



Learning Disability England will help make that review happen.

They will work with Partnership Board members and other people in Kent that the Board is connected to.

They will link to the work NDTi are doing on a big plan.

There are 3 stages to the plan

Stage 1 - Holding meetings on the 3 big areas people want the review to cover



- Learning Disability England will lead 1 session and make a pack to help everyone think about the big issues.
- Local groups could run their own sessions on the questions using the pack.
- We could have an online survey too if people think that will help some people have a say.
- We can ask people to share ideas or information by email too if they want to.

There are 3 stages to the plan

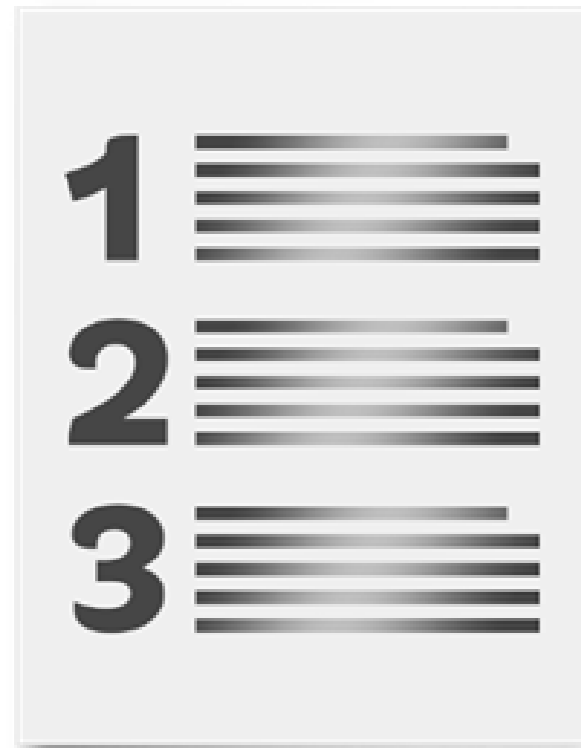
Stage 2 – Collecting all the ideas and feedback



- Learning Disability England will organise all the ideas and feedback from the local meetings and other feedback.
- A small group from the Partnership Board will work with Learning Disability England to check all the ideas and work out what is important to do next.

Stage 2 – Collecting all the ideas and feedback



The small group will write a draft plan for:

1. How the board and meetings work
2. How the board is connected to other people or groups
3. How the board can make a difference

There are 3 stages to the plan

Stage 3 – Agreeing the plan



The Partnership Board will meet to look at all the ideas and agree the plan for how the Board will work in the future.

The Partnership Board can decide when the work starts.

It will take 4 months at least to do the review.

The Partnership Board needs to decide when it wants to make the changes by.
