## What is the Kent and Medway Care Record (KMCR)?

The Kent and Medway Care Record is a single, shared care record for each patient who is cared for by the NHS or Social Services in Kent and Medway.

Relevant information from the record will be seen by all the health and care professionals who need to see it.

Patients will be able to access their own records as well.



## Creating a shared record could:

- Stop people having to tell the same story lots of times to different organisations
- Improve the quality of clinical and professional decisions
- Support better integrated care by sharing information across teams
- Keep people safer.

## What information will be on the Kent and Medway Care Record?

- Demographics (age, ethnicity, race)
- Next of Kin / Carer details
- Medications (current)
- Allergies
- Safeguarding alerts
- Pathology results
- Alerts / flags
- Chronological list of contact with health and social care professionals, including A&E attendances



- Key social care data
- Mental health summary data including medication
- Referrals to other organisations
- Carer & care provider details (multiple agencies and contact details for each organisation)
- The current location of the patient - inpatient, care home, step-down
- Advance Directives - Do Not Attempt Resuscitation (DNAR)
- Care plans (including end of life plans, crisis care plans)

- This is due to start in October 2021.

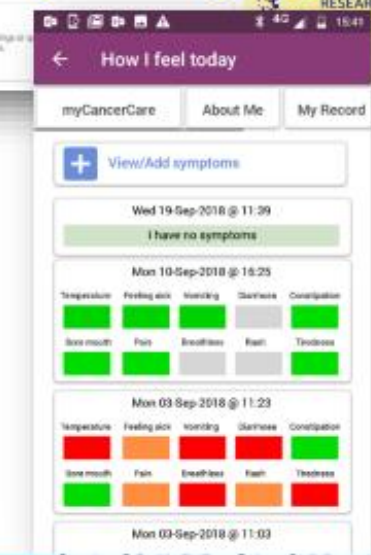
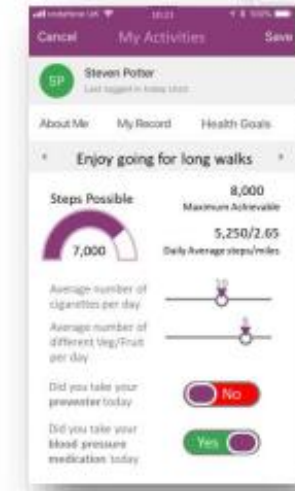
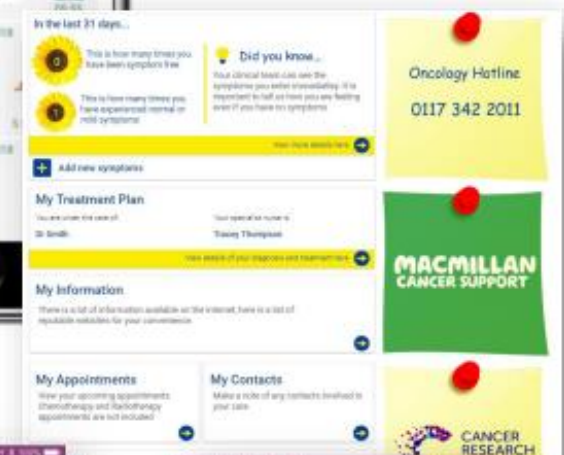


# My Care Record

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## Some examples

- ▶ Covid symptom tracking
- ▶ Epilepsy
  - Using detailed wearable data
- ▶ Cardiac Heart Failure
  - Using devices in the home and portal diary entry
- ▶ Healthy Living
  - Using wearable activity data
- ▶ Cancer Care support
  - Allowing triage teams to see recent symptoms immediately
- ▶ All About Me
  - Updated following patient engagement & PRSB recommendations
- ▶ Frailty
  - Driven by BI
  - Immediate access to information
- ▶ Maternity Personalised Care Plans
- ▶ Diabetes control
- ▶ LTC annual assessments
