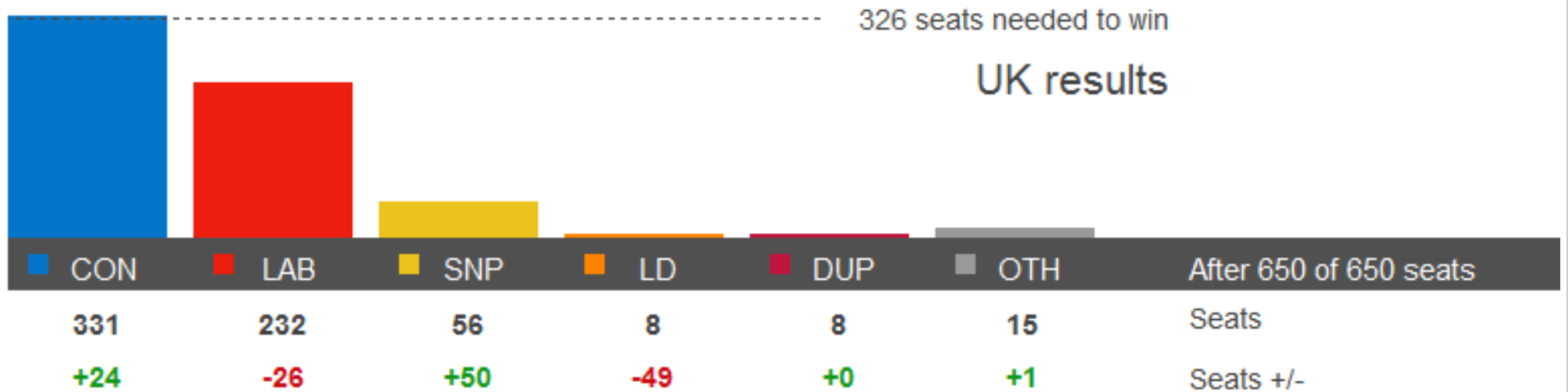
The General Election 2015

DUP = Democratic Unionist Party (Northern Ireland)

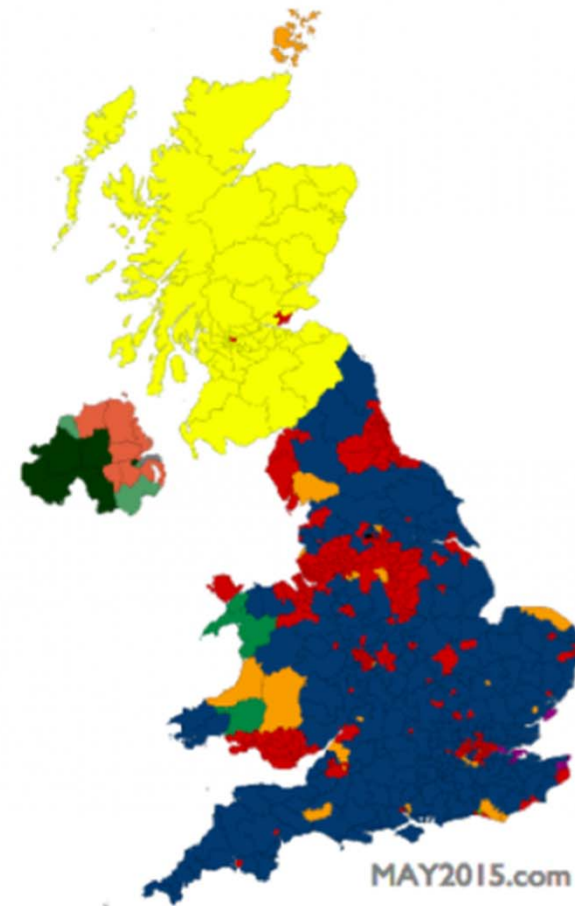
OTH = Others
