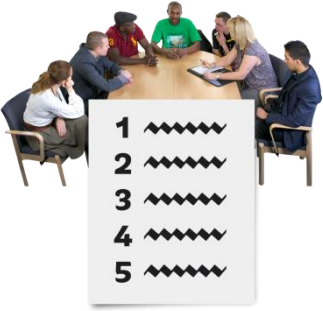


# Kent Valuing People Now Contract
